

Precautionary Measures to be observed during Mass attendance

Precautionary measures to be observed while participating in Holy Eucharist at St Mary's Cathedral Hobart and Sacred Heart Church, Newtown:

⇒ **Check- In:**

Now that the Tasmania Government has opened the Tasmanian borders and due to work, health and safety requirements, please kindly observe all the COVID 19 safety regulations by using the Check-In QR Codes and hand sanitise as you enter any Cathedral Parish buildings and Do Not Enter any Cathedral Parish buildings if you:-

- ⇒ Have COVID 19
- ⇒ Have been instructed to quarantine
- ⇒ Are unwell, including with fever, respiratory symptoms, eg: shortness of breath, cough sore throat.

Please check-in using the QR Codes or the written register in the foyer of the Cathedral and at Sacred Heart Church.

⇒ **Face Masks:**

As the Tasmania Government has mandated mask wearing Face mask wearing will be mandatory for all people attending any 'religious gathering'.

⇒ **Sanitize:**

Please sanitise your hands with the hand sanitiser provided at the foyer before entering and exiting the Church. Kindly avoid any contacts with doors and pews other than the one you occupy.

⇒ **Social Distancing:**

Strictly follow the instructions provided by the ushers and maintain the social distancing of 1.5 m from each other. Please don't gather in and around the Church before and after the Mass.

⇒ **During Communion:**

For health, safety, and hygiene purposes it is encouraged to receive Holy Communion in your hands.

Due to COVID 19 safety regulations and the concerns of parishioners may I kindly urge those parishioners who wish to receive communion on the tongue to please receive the Eucharist at the end of Communion. I thank you all for your understanding and co-operation.

Please ensure you stand on the marked area during this to promote social distancing.
